Action to Reverse Pay Cuts

I am to advise you that as and from **Monday 22nd March 2010**, I do not wish to be contacted on my personal mobile phone whilst on duty and I will not be making my personal equipment available to work.

At a time of severe financial hardship, brought about by arbitrary cuts in pay by Government and levies, I can no longer carry the large bills incurred by the use of my mobile phone at work, and by the provision of personal equipment and I am not compensated by the State for using either.

In addition, I do not wish to be contacted on my personal mobile phone or on my home telephone while off duty and I will not be responding to phone calls to either phone whilst off duty. I wish to have my home and mobile telephone numbers removed from all Station records.

Finally, where I am required to attend at either Circuit or High Court hearings, I wish to be issued in advance with the written relevant summons, in accordance with the principles of law.
